7. People's Choice Award.

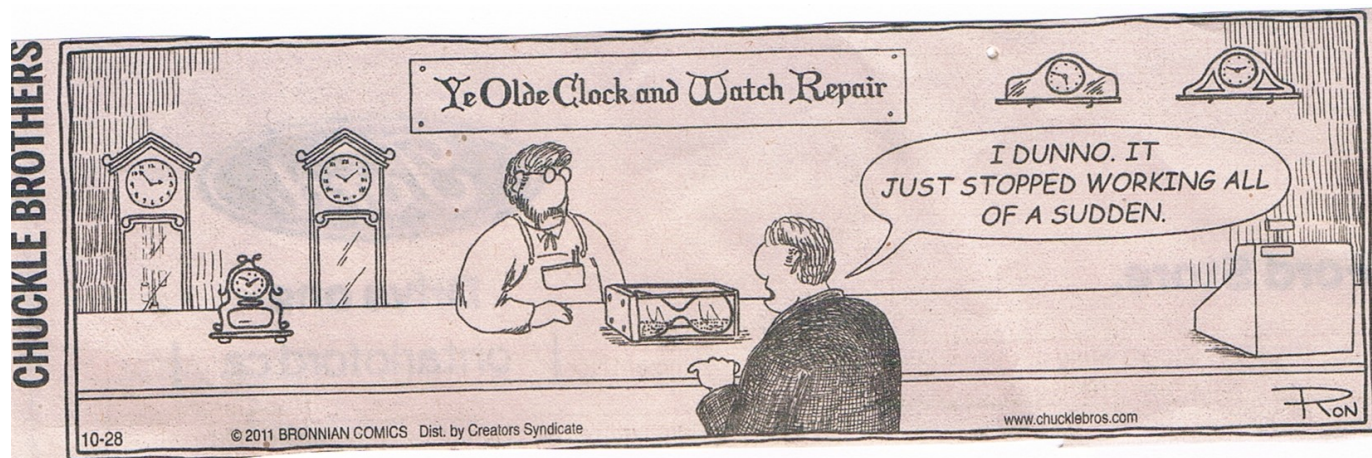

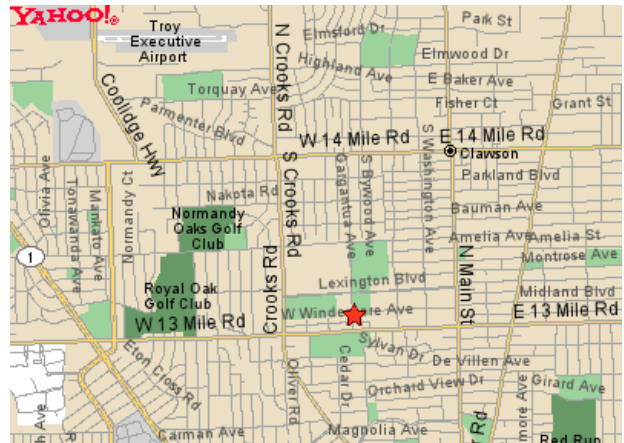
