NOTICE OF AMMENDMENT:

A vote will be held at the October Meeting to change the wording in the constitution regarding the number of Directors allowed. The Board is requesting the addition of the word 'minimum' in Article 5. The proposed additional wording is indicated in red:

BOARD OF DIRECTORS:

The governing authorities of the Chapter shall be the Board of Directors (Board) consisting of **a minimum of** eight (8) Directors. The Board shall have full authority in all matters as defined by this Constitution and the By-laws and shall manage and control the business and property of the Chapter. The term of office for the Directors will be two (2) years.
